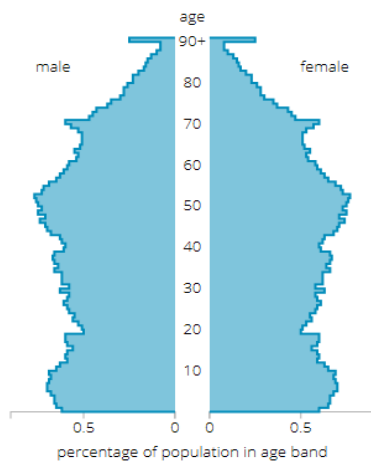

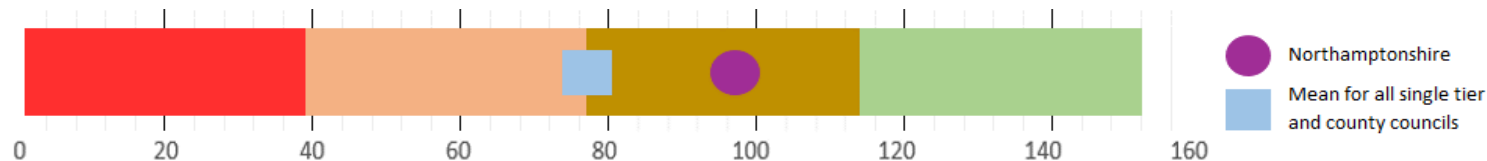

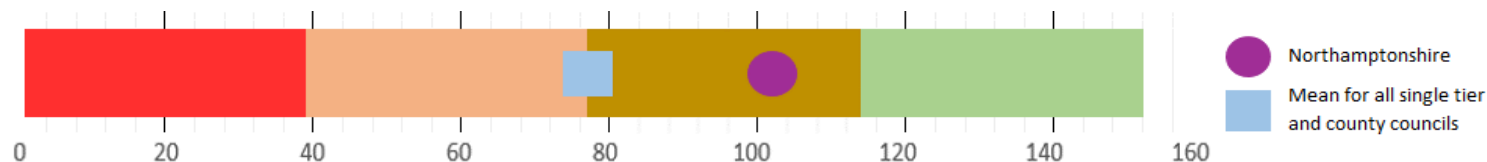

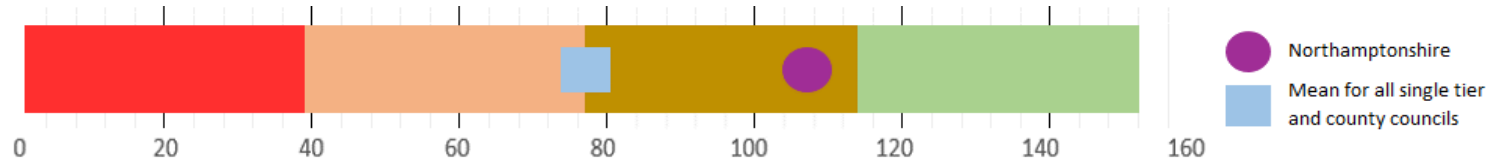
IMD Overall - Rank for all single tier and county authorities (quantiles of all English single tier and county councils)



IMD Income Deprivation Affecting Older People Index (IDAOPI) - Rank for all single tier and county authorities (2015)

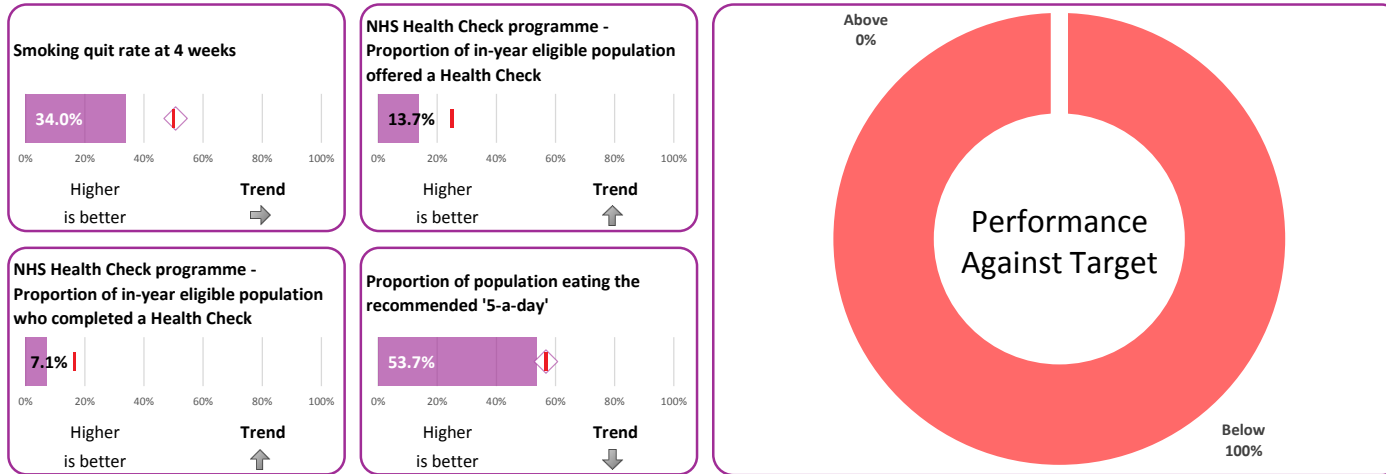


IMD Income Deprivation Affecting Children Index (IDACI) - Rank for all single tier and county authorities (2015)
